



Pharmacist Preceptors' Training Programme (Foundational)

The Pharmacist Preceptors' Training Programme aims to promote the development of foundational teaching skills for pharmacist preceptors. The modules are constructed around themes that support individual participant's learning in their specific teaching context.

This 1-day Foundational Programme, offered by the National Healthcare Group (NHG), is accredited by the Singapore Pharmacy Council (SPC) for meeting the training requirements to be a Preceptor for Pre-Registration Pharmacists.

Learning Outcomes

- Outline the goals of preceptorship, the professional activities and expectations of a preceptor
- 2. Describe the values expected of a preceptor.
- 3. Employ effective communication skills to provide feedback to pre-registration pharmacists
- 4. Develop teaching, precepting, coaching and supervisory skills
- 5. Plan activities to support teaching and learning
- 6. Conduct appropriate assessments adequately, including the use of work-based assessment tools and professional activities
- 7. Facilitate constructive and reflective feedback to enhance learning.
- 8. Apply self-leadership in order to effectively lead others
- 9. Adopt a growth mindset to reflect on own practice and identity areas for improvement
