NEW PRACTISING CERTIFICATE FEE FROM 1 FEBRUARY 2025

From **1 February 2025**, the Singapore Nursing Board (SNB) will revise its fees for practising certificate (PC) for nurses and midwives. The yearly PC fee will increase by \$10 for Registered Nurse/Registered Nurse (Psychiatric), \$5 for Enrolled Nurse/Enrolled Nurse (Psychiatric)/Midwife and \$15 for Advanced Practice Nurse (see Table below).

Enrolled Nurse	\$30	\$35
Enrolled Nurse (Psychiatric)	\$30	\$35
Midwife	\$30	\$35
Advanced Practice Nurse	\$60	\$75

2. Nurses and midwives who submit their application for a new PC or renew their PC from 1 February 2025 will pay the new fee.

3. We seek your understanding that this fee revision is necessary to enable SNB to continue its functions under the Nurses and Midwives Act 1999. While SNB has been managing costs prudently, SNB has not adjusted its PC fees for the past 12 years despite inflation and rising operating costs.

4. SNB will continue to review its fees and costs regularly to ensure that high standards of healthcare services are provided by all our healthcare practitioners.
5. Information on the updated Fees Schedule for new and renewal of PC applications will be available on the SNB website at www.snb.gov.sg by 1 February 2025.
