## Criteria for the Award of Continuing Professional Education (CPE) Points

A CPE point is a unit of credit that recognises nurses' and midwives' participation in **nursing/healthcare related** learning events. Learning undertaken by nurses/midwives should be **relevant or appropriate** to nurses or midwives' **context and scope of practice**, with the aim to maintain, improve, deepen, and broaden their knowledge, skills, and competence. CPE includes participation at in-services, lectures, seminars, conferences and workshops; enrolment in formal courses; self-directed learning and/or reading; workplace-based learning (On-the-Job); facilitation/participation of research events; oral and poster presentations and publications.

Requirements for the renewal of Practicing Certificate (Pre-Mandatory Phase for Nurses/Midwives)

- A Registered Nurse is to attain 15 CPE points per year.
- An Enrolled Nurse and/or Midwife (Single Register) is to attain 10 CPE points per year.
- An **Advanced Practice Nurse** is to attain **30 CPE points per year** (Mandatory),of which at least 15 CPE must be related to Advanced Practice Nursing or clinical specialty.
- CPE points will be awarded for delivering the lecture for the first time only. Full-time educators
  cannot claim CPE points for presentations/lectures that are part of their job expectations but
  may use other presentations made outside the duties of their role. Similarly, a nurse researcher
  cannot claim CPE for research works (presentation & publication).
- Nurses on Provisional Registration are not required to attain CPE points during their Competency Assessment Period
